

GREDO 2022 PROGRAM BULLETIN

OVERVIEW

During 2022, GREDO implemented 23 projects in 16 districts in South-central Somalia and reached **865,859** beneficiaries.

The bulletin shows key achievements across GREDO interventions during 2022, marking a year when humanitarian needs were the most due to drought and armed conflicts.

GREDO's 2022 programmatic themes included education, Health and Nutrition, WASH, FS&L, Environmental management, and governance, promoting access to basic human rights, women empowerment, and protection of the vulnerable communities IDPs, and returnees.

In 2022 GREDO implemented 17 emergency projects in 9 districts.
