OVERVIEW

The latest assessment indicated that the April to June 2023 Gu season rainfall is expected to be near average, which may contribute to the partial recovery of cropping and livestock production conditions in Somalia. However, many poor and destitute agropastoral households no longer possess the necessary asset base or purchasing power to reinvest in their traditional agricultural livelihoods. Consequently, it is projected that the Gu harvest expected in July, along with associated crop sales and labor income, will fall below the 10-year average. The impact of the rains on livestock reproduction will only become apparent during the subsequent birthing period, which is anticipated to occur in the 2023 Deyr season

In response to the drought impacts, GREDO has made significant achievements across all program sectors in the past two months, reaching over 700,000 individuals in 18 districts and sub-villages in South and Central Somalia through 29 active projects. GREDO's programs have provided essential services to vulnerable populations, including health and nutrition services, WASH interventions, support for livelihoods and food security, education support, and child protection and safeguarding interventions. GREDO's efforts in promoting sustainability and building resilience in the face of future shocks are crucial in ensuring the long-term well-being of the populations served.



HEALTH & NUTRITION



GREDO's Health and Nutrition program has made significant achievements in the past two months by reaching over 176,000 individuals in South-Central Somalia. The organization conducted screenings for malnutrition and provided admission for MAM and SAM services. GREDO also provided IYCF counseling sessions and supported children through EPI services. The program's goal is to improve the health and nutrition status of vulnerable populations in the region. The organization's interventions have helped to prevent and treat malnutrition, which is a critical issue in Somalia, particularly among children. GREDO's efforts in promoting health and nutrition have contributed to the well-being of communities, and the organization's commitment to improving health outcomes is essential in ensuring the long-term health and well-being of the populations served.



Health Service

62,789 individuals including 32,298 under five children were supported through basic health services



ANC/PNC & Safe Delivery

18,286 pregnant and lactating mothers were supported through ANC, PNC and safe delivery services.



SAM/MAM Malnutrition

37,933 children were screened against malnutrition. 8,169 admitted for MAM and SAM services.



IYCF education & Counseling

38,684 parents were supported through IYCF father-2-father and mother-2-mother group sessions & individual counseling.



EPI Services

10,757 children were supported through EPI services.



PROTECTION & SAFEGUARDING

GREDO's Child Protection and Safeguarding program aims to protect children and vulnerable individuals from abuse, exploitation, and neglect and promote their well-being. It has made significant achievements in providing support to vulnerable individuals, managing and supporting GBV cases, providing psychosocial support. It has made the following achievements:



329 dignity kits and material support kits distributed



155 GBV cases managed and supported through dignity kits.



401 individuals supported through psychosocial support.



WASH



12,144HH reached through cleanup campaigns & 200HH were given sanitation tools.



2,500HH reached through hygiene promotion and 5,059HH given hygiene kits.



136 Community Hygiene Volunteers were trained



Rehabilitation/Construction of 4 strategic boreholes is on ongoing



Rehabilitation/Construction of 15 shallow wells and 1 pipeline extension is ongoing



Construction of 126 latrines ongoing



GREDO implemented reached a total of 49,299 households through WASH activities. This includes 12,144 households reached through cleanup campaigns, 200 households given sanitation tools, and 2,500 households reached through hygiene promotion campaigns. GREDO also provided hygiene kits to 5,059 households and trained 136 Community Hygiene Volunteers (CHVs). Additionally, GREDO has ongoing rehabilitation and construction activities for water sources, latrines, and community assets, including the rehabilitation/construction of four strategic boreholes, 15 shallow wells, and a pipeline extension and the construction of 126 latrines.



FSL AND RESILIENCE

GREDO provided support to 32,455 households through Multipurpose Cash Assistance (MPCA) in May and June 2023. This was done in 9 districts in South-Central Somalia through 10 Food Security and Livelihood projects. GREDO's FSL and resilience interventions aim to assist vulnerable households in rebuilding their livelihoods and addressing the long-term effects of the drought on their agricultural activities.



32,455 households were supported through Unconditional Multipurpose Cash Assistance

EDUCATION

GREDO supported education in six districts through three projects in May and June 22. A total of 23,890 learners were enrolled, and 196 teachers were trained on pedagogy and child-friendly teaching methodologies. GREDO also built/rehabilitated 17 TLS/schools and supported eight schools through water trucking. In addition, GREDO supported 17 Village Savings and Loans Association (VSLA) groups.

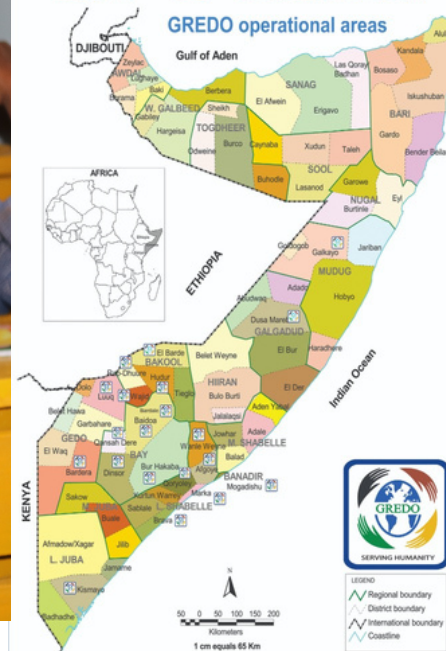
